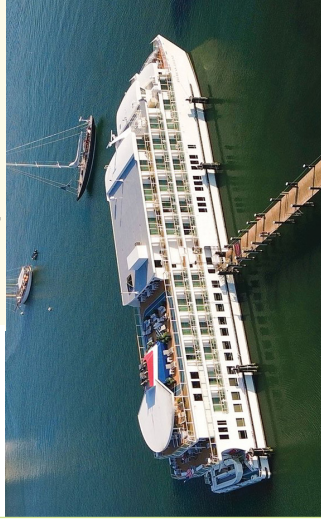

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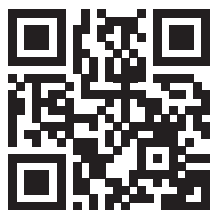

June 19: Boston, Massachusetts - Included Hotel Stay

June 20: Boston, Massachusetts - Embarkation & Begin Cruising

June 21: Provincetown, Massachusetts

Provincetown sits at the tip of Cape Cod, where dunes and lighthouses stand alongside galleries and a deeply rooted creative culture. Its harbor has welcomed fishermen, writers, and painters for generations, giving the town a unique energy unlike anywhere else along the Massachusetts coast.

June 22: Plymouth, Massachusetts

Plymouth holds a central place in early American history, with landmarks tied to the Pilgrims and colonial settlement. Plymouth Rock and the Mayflower II continue to mark the town's longstanding place in the nation's founding narrative.

June 23: Mass. Maritime Academy, Massachusetts

June 26: New Bedford, Massachusetts

New Bedford rose to prominence as one of the world's leading whaling ports during the mid-19th century. Today, its cobbled streets, preserved waterfront, and maritime museums reflect a legacy that inspired Herman Melville's *Moby Dick*.

June 27: Boston, Massachusetts

Return to Boston, bringing your voyage full circle in one of New England's most historic port cities.
