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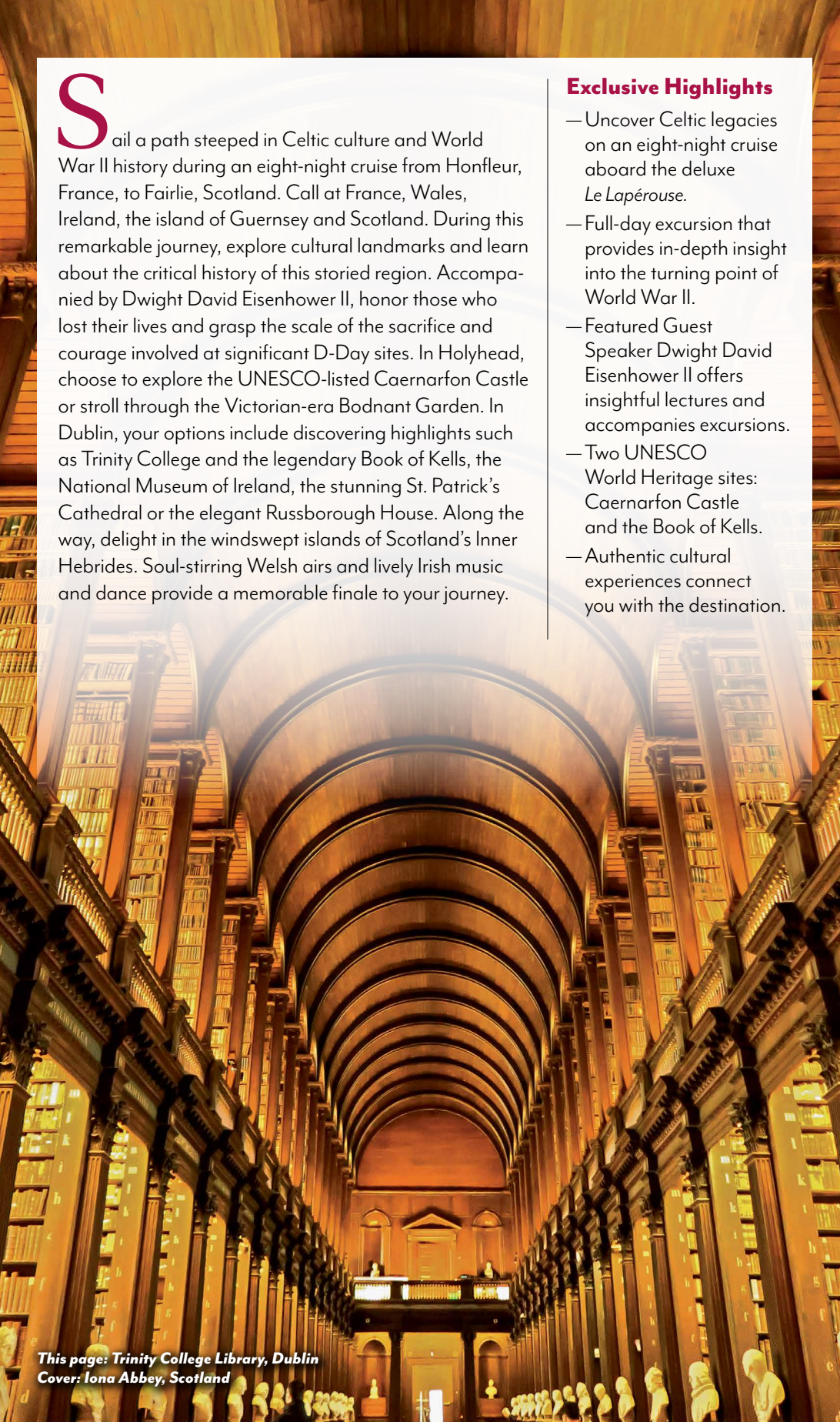

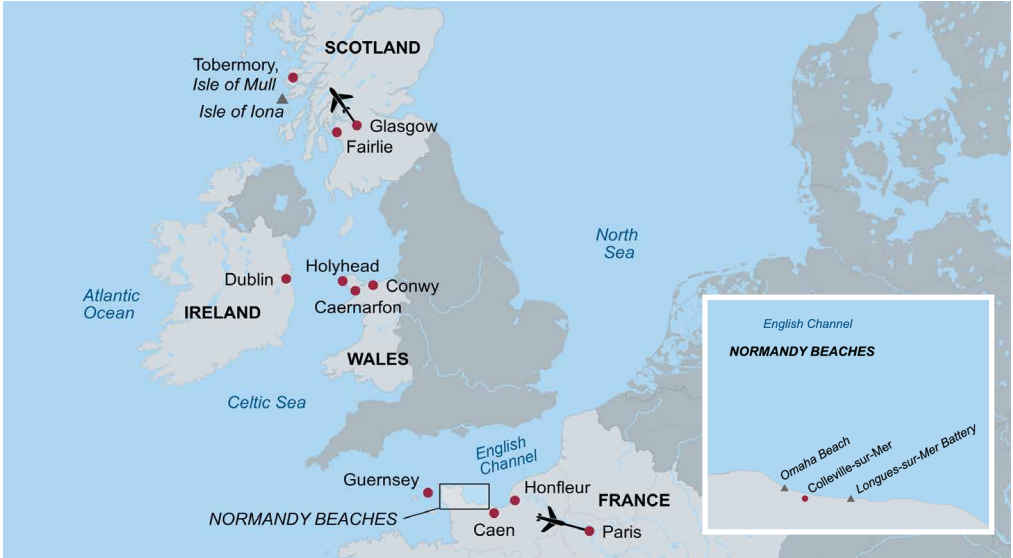
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Professor Kathryn Norberg, Department of History



Until her retirement in 2023, Kathryn Norberg taught European history in the UCLA Department of History for 36 years. She is the author or editor of seven books dealing with topics as diverse as the history of charity, fiscal crises, women in revolution, eighteenth-century furniture and fashion prints in the age of Louis XIV. Her most recent project analyzes life in an eighteenth-century Paris brothel. Her teaching at UCLA covered Europe from the early Middle Ages to 1800. She has traveled through Normandy many times and has a particular interest in the English channel and its islands.

Day 1 | May 1

Depart your home city for an overnight flight to Paris, France.

Day 2 | May 2 **D**

Paris, France | Honfleur | Embark

Arrive in Paris, transfer to Honfleur and embark the deluxe *Le Lapérouse*. After settling in your cabin, take time to explore. Meet new friends during your first dinner as the ship departs for Caen.

Day 3 | May 3 **B-L-R-D**

Longues-sur-Mer | Colleville-sur-Mer | Omaha Beach

Disembark this morning and set out to explore the historic sites of Operation Overlord, one of the most pivotal campaigns of World War II. Join Featured Guest Speaker Dwight David Eisenhower II for an insightful talk. Then travel to Longues-sur-Mer to see the well-preserved coastal German artillery battery positioned between Omaha and Gold landing beaches and ideally located for the Germans

to fight Allied forces coming ashore. Continue to Colleville-sur-Mer, where Professor Eisenhower leads a walk through the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial, reminding visitors of the human cost of war and the importance of preserving peace. Stand on Omaha Beach, the six-mile stretch of beach that became the deadliest and most intense battlefield of the invasion. Today's excursion brings the reality of D-Day to life in a way no book or film can and highlights why the lessons of D-Day — courage, sacrifice and cooperation — are still important today.

Day 4 | May 4 **B-L-D**

Guernsey, Channel Islands

Join David Eisenhower for another insightful lecture this morning. After lunch, enjoy a memorable journey that showcases Guernsey's breathtaking coastline, history and cultural landmarks. Begin at the Little Chapel, one of the world's smallest churches, lovingly decorated with sea-shells, pebbles and colorful fragments of china. This charming, hand-built chapel offers a glimpse into the island's unique religious heritage. Continue along the dramatic south coast, known for its rugged cliffs, scenic bays and panoramic sea views.



A highlight of this section is Pleinmont Point, a windswept headland offering striking views of the Atlantic. It is also home to the Pleinmont Observation Tower, a concrete structure built by German forces during World War II. Between 1942 and 1945, this tower formed part of Hitler's Atlantic Wall — an extensive coastal defense system constructed during the Nazi occupation of the Channel Islands. The tower stands as a stark reminder of Guernsey's wartime past. The experience concludes in St Peter Port.

Day 5 | May 5 **B-L-D**
Day at Sea

Cruising between Guernsey and Holyhead offers a scenic journey across the Irish Sea and English Channel, blending rugged Welsh coastlines with the tranquil charm of the Channel Islands.

Day 6 | May 6 **B-L-D**
Holyhead, Wales

Arrive in Holyhead after breakfast and set off on your chosen excursion. Select to visit the UNESCO-listed medieval Caernarfon Castle, built in the late 13th century by Edward I, or treat your senses to the world-famous

Bodnant Gardens, a haven of glorious colors and lily ponds set in the Conway Valley.

Back on board tonight, listen to a traditional Welsh choir tonight, a moving experience, as rich harmonies and voices fill the air with centuries-old musical heritage.

Day 7 | May 7 **B-L-D**
Dublin, Ireland

Disembark to discover friendly Dublin with your selected Traveler's Choice excursion. Explore the city's sights, including Trinity College to see the legendary Book of Kells, the illuminated manuscript created by medieval monks.

You may also opt to visit the National Museum of Ireland, where fascinating exhibits bring Ireland's rich history and heritage to life or visit the stunning architectural landmark of St. Patrick's Cathedral, including a stop at Teeling Distillery to learn about whiskey-making traditions. A final option is to experience the elegance of Russborough House, a magnificent Palladian mansion set in the countryside, where you will enjoy an engaging falconry display.

Before dinner, enjoy a performance of traditional Irish music and dancing, a living tradition tied to community and heritage. Both Irish music and dance have been passed down through generations.

Tobermory, Isle of Mull, Scotland

Nestled on the northeastern coast of the Isle of Mull, the charming town of Tobermory is known for its brightly painted harbor and maritime history. Founded in 1788 as a fishing port, it later became associated with legends of shipwrecks, including a Spanish galleon said to have sunk in its bay. Enjoy an excursion that showcases its coastal scenery and heritage.

Day 9 | May 9

Iona

Dig into breakfast as the ship approaches Iona in Scotland's Inner Hebrides. Gain insight into a sacred, enduring symbol of worship at Iona



Abbey, considered the birthplace of Christianity in Scotland. The monks of Iona spread Christian ideas across Scotland and the north. Over the years, the abbey endured Viking raids and periods of decline. It was later restored and remains an active place of worship today. St. Martin's Cross still stands by the roadside.

Celebrate at a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.

His 1986 bestseller, "Eisenhower: At War 1943–1945," was a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize in History. Eisenhower received a B.A. in history cum laude from Amherst College. Following graduation, he served in the United States Naval Reserve for three years as an officer on the USS Albany; shortly afterward, he earned his J.D. cum laude from The George Washington University Law School. Today, Eisenhower is Senior Fellow of the Foreign Policy Research Institute and a Public Policy Fellow at the Annenberg School of Communication and the School of Arts and Sciences at the University of Pennsylvania, where he teaches "Communication and the Presidency."
