



Ann M. Stewart

May 12, 1926 - December 20, 2014

Ann McCament Stewart passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 20, in her home town of Pasadena, California.

Born Ann Baird McCament on May 12, 1926, she was educated in Pasadena and attended Pasadena Community College and UCLA, where she was a member of Kappa Alpha Theta Sorority. She was also a Princess in the 1944 Tournament of Roses.

In 1952, she married Richard Savage Stewart. After he completed his service in the Korean Conflict, they lived in Weston, Massachusetts; Concord, New Hampshire; Oxford, Mississippi; Ann Arbor, Michigan; and New York City.

She returned to Pasadena in 1970, and joined the Department of Faculty Records at USC, from which she retired as a Manager. She also served as a Docent at Descanso Gardens for many years.

She is survived by her sister, Mary-Stuart Hackett; her children, Alexander, John and Victoria; and five grandchildren, Hannah, Grace, Brian, Emily and Amanda.
