Alumni Scholarships Program Purpose & Goals



Develop future generations of diverse leaders who value giving back, civic engagement, and lifelong engagement with UCLA

Current State of Financial Needs & Admissions at UCLA

THEN AND NOW

1936

- \$27 Annual incidental fee for California residents
- \$85 Monthly living expenses (clothing, food, fuel, housing)
- \$150 Amount of original scholarship, a onetime award worth \$2,679.61 in 2018 dollars

2018-2019

- \$13,285 University fees for California residents
- **\$15,816** Annual room and meals
- \$6,000 Amount of typical scholarship today paid over four years








Total Scholarship Dollars Awarded



Current Model Unsustainable

- ① Limited network resources
- ② Award amounts need to be materially larger (\$10,000 annually)

Board CommitmentGrowing Student Support

Economic Model

Determine and establish level of individual scholarship awards that create meaningful financial support beginning with the 2020-21 academic year. Build in future increases as will be projected in a budget planning model.

Funding Model

Centralize award funds into shared pool, maximizing ability to fundraise and providing consistency for awarding; preserve characteristics of network funds and incorporate network strengths.

Funding Sources

Enable Board and volunteer leaders to champion and communicate need for and impact of meaningful awards. Require Board members to raise/donate to Scholarship General Fund at personally meaningful level. Hire development officer to focus on Alumni Program fundraising, grants, corporate opportunities.

- Created by Alumni Association leadership to focus on fundraising for scholarships
- Shared commitment to student support

- Engaged donor-volunteer led Board (concurrently serve on 35 boards and campaign committees across campus)
- Oversight of UCLA Investment Company
- Investment Policy Statement & payout rate



Next Steps Timeline

- December 7 : update Network leaders
- January 2020 : Scholarship Fundraising and Stewardship Training
- ▶ Winter 2020 : Virtual application reading, including Alumni Network participation; Individual interviews phased out due to yield timing determined by Enrollment Management; National Finalists determined by top combined score from virtual reading + application read score
- March-April 2020 : execute plan to support Office of Enrollment Management recruitment efforts
- April-May 2020 : execute plan to support Office of Enrollment Management yield efforts
- ▶ June-August 2020 : execute plan for new scholars welcome activities
- September 2020 + : execute Network/Alumni Scholar engagement plan
