



He served as UCLA History Department chair (2002-2005) and chair of the Department of Spanish and Portuguese (2008-2009). A medievalist and early modern historian, Ruiz was selected by the Carnegie Foundation as one of the four Outstanding Teachers of the Year in 1994. The author of 14 books, he received the prestigious 2007 Guggenheim Fellowship and the **Distinguished Teacher** Award at UCLA. In 2012, Ruiz was selected as the Senior Research Lecturer at UCLA and received the National Humanities Medal from President Obama. With 13 past tours, Professor Ruiz is the most popular and beloved lecturer traveling with UCLA Alumni Travel.

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Verona, Italy.

Day 2 | Verona

Transfer **3** to the Grand Hotel des Arts.

Socialize with your fellow travelers at this evening's Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Verona

Enrichment: *History and Architecture*

of the Veneto. The vibrant Veneto region lies in Italy's northeast corner between the Dolomite Mountains and the Adriatic Sea. From Roman ruins to medieval churches to Renaissance palaces, its architecture tells the region's story under Roman rulers and powerful families.

Discovery: *Verona.* Explore this enchanting, very walkable city, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the setting of Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet." Begin at the Arena, built in the first century. During the city's annual summer opera festival, thousands of spectators enjoy open-air entertainment here, just as past audiences reveled in gladiator contests and medieval tournaments. Visit lively Piazza Bra and Piazza Erbe, surrounded by grand palazzi. Juliet's House and her balcony are close by. Conclude with lunch in the historic center.

Free Time: Spend your afternoon at leisure. If you'd like, join an optional walk across the Adige River, and take in scenic sunset views in the cypress-lined Giusti Gardens.

Day 4 | Lake Garda | Valpolicella Winery

Discovery: Lake Garda. The resplendent

beauty of Italy's largest lake has long inspired poets and writers. Appreciate its allure as you travel to glamorous Sirmione, a resort town on a narrow peninsula at the lake's southern end, known for its ruins of a Roman villa and Rocca Scaligera, a 13th-century castle. Cruise across the shimmering water to picturesque Lazise.

Coali. The Valpolicella wine region east of Lake Garda produces acclaimed red wines. Visit a small, family-owned winery for lunch and a tasting in the countryside.

Enrichment: *Contemporary Italy.* Discuss issues influencing Italian society.

Day 5 | Venice

Discovery: *Venice.* Board a high-speed train bound for Venice this morning. This most entrancing city, where arched bridges stretch over tiny canals and narrow walkways lead to astonishing churches and lovely palazzi, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Cruise by private boat along the Grand Canal, then start your guided walk. Stand in the center of St. Mark's Square, bordered by palatial



arcades and cafés, and gaze up at the stately Campanile bell tower and the elaborate St. Mark's Clock Tower. Admire the Byzantine façade of St. Mark's Basilica and tour its glittering, mosaic-covered interior. Visit the lavish Doge's Palace, the political heart of the once mighty Venetian Republic.

Free Time: Enjoy lunch and explore more before returning to Verona by train.

Day 6 | Verona

Enrichment: Music and the Arts of

Verona. Learn about the city's long and proud tradition of supporting the performing arts.

Free Time: The day is yours to plan! Perhaps you'll take a stroll and linger in inviting squares like the Piazza dei Signori, or browse on the city's main shopping avenues, the Via Mazzini and the Corso Porta Borsari.

Look forward to a special Veronese dinner this evening, capped off by an exclusive operatic performance.

Day 7 | Bassano del Grappa | Vicenza

Discovery: *Cities of Veneto.* Journey to Bassano del Grappa in the foothills of the Italian Alps, which boasts a covered wooden bridge designed by the famed Renaissance architect, Andrea Palladio. Walk over the bridge and then sample aromatic grappa, a classic brandy that's been produced here since the Middle Ages. Head next to Vicenza, known as the city of Palladio and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to delve into this influential architect's work. View Vence Lake Garde Vence Vence Padua TALY Adviatic Sea Tala

the loggias of Basilica dei Signori and visit Teatro Olimpico, his majestic indoor homage to ancient Roman theaters. Then, savor lunch at a family-owned restaurant/deli that specializes in a popular dish, *baccalà*, or codfish.

Free Time: Pursue your own interests when you return to Verona this afternoon.

Day 8 | Padua | Villa Pisani

Discovery: Padua and the Villa Pisani.

Venture off to Padua, another of Veneto's medieval gems, richly steeped in the cultural traditions of art and learning. With your guide, walk through the historic center's arcaded streets and see its highlights. Meander in the vast square Prato della Valle, a favorite of locals and students from the University of Padua, founded in 1222. Inside Scrovegni Chapel, marvel at the spectacular frescoes painted by Giotto in the early 1300s, depicting the lives of the Virgin Mary and Christ, which

are regarded as a milestone in Western art. Spend some time on your own for lunch and sightseeing before rejoining the group. Depart for a tour of Villa Pisani, the most sumptuous of the Venetian villas. Once owned by Napoleon, it hosted emperors and kings in its heyday in the early 1800s. The villa's landscaped gardens also feature Europe's most challenging garden maze.

With your fellow travelers, celebrate the journey you've shared at a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.
