Sault Ste. Marie is the oldest city in the Midwest—it features New Fort Brady and the Valley Camp Museum Ship. Here you can also visit the mighty Soo Locks, one of the world's largest and busiest set of locks, which enable ships to travel between Lake Superior and the lower Great Lakes.

DAY 11: MACKINAC ISLAND, MICHIGAN

Step back into the nineteenth century on Mackinac Island. Steeped in Victorianera charm, the island has a no-car policy—hail a horse-drawn carriage or explore the island's attractions by bicycle. Hike through Mackinac Island State Park to fully appreciate the beauty of this island's woodlands and rocky outcrops, or spend a day discovering the delightful downtown art galleries and boutiques.

DAY 12: MUSKEGON, MICHIGAN

With an array of outdoor parks, twenty-six miles of sandy beaches, and opportunities for upscale dining, Muskegon has something for everyone. Spend time here at the USS LST 393 Veterans Museum or tour the USS *Silversides* to get a look at what it was like to sail in an old-fashioned submarine.
