Day 2 | Naples, Italy | Vietri sul Mare

Discovery: Enchanting Isle of Capri. This star-studded destination has been an exclusive getaway since the 1950s when Elizabeth Taylor, Sophia Loren and other celebrities came to enjoy la dolce vita. Travel via hydrofoil to Capri; then experience the bewitching coast by boat as you pass by swimming coves and caves. Back on land, spend time at leisure in Capri. Browse the boutiques on Via Vittorio Emanuele and Via Camerelle or try the city's famous cake made from ground almonds and dark chocolate. You may wish to visit the Augustus Gardens, a paradise filled with terraces of blossoming vines, lily ponds and statues. The gardens offer a grand overlook to view the Faraglioni, a trio of rocks rising from the sea.

Day 8 | Herculaneum and Pompeii
