**Aaron A. Burke**

Aaron Burke is Professor of the Archaeology of Ancient Israel and the Levant, and the Kershaw Chair in the Archaeology of the Ancient Eastern Mediterranean in the Department of Near Eastern Languages and Cultures. He is also a faculty member of the Cotsen Institute of Archaeology at UCLA, where he is currently editor-in-chief of its press. He received his Ph.D. in Near Eastern Archaeology from The Oriental Institute at The University of Chicago in 2004. From 2011 to 2014, as director of the Jaffa Cultural Heritage Project, he conducted excavations of a New Kingdom Egyptian fortress in Jaffa, Israel. In 2017, expanding upon his research in Jaffa, he inaugurated, Turning Points, an initiative aimed at exploring the broad context of the transition between the Late Bronze Age and early Iron Age out of which ancient Israel emerged. In addition to his monograph, Walled Up to Heaven: The Evolution of Middle Bronze Age Fortification Strategies in the Levant, he has written extensively on warfare and society in the Bronze and Iron ages, and has co-edited three volumes resulting from directing archaeological work in Jaffa. He has excavated in Israel, Turkey, and Egypt, and travelled as well throughout Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Cyprus, Turkey, and Greece. He is President of the Los Angeles Chapter of the Archaeological Institute of America.

### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Tel Aviv, Israel. 🌐

### Day 2 | Tel Aviv, Israel

Transfer 🔄 and check in to the Carlton Tel Aviv. Gather for a Welcome Reception at the hotel.

### Day 3 | Tel Aviv

**Discovery: Enchanting Jaffa.** Located just a few miles up the coast from Tel Aviv, Jaffa is one of the most enchanting, old-world places in Israel. Soak up the beguiling atmosphere as you stroll cobbled alleyways, browse a bustling flea market and chat with friendly, local artisans.

**Discovery: Neve Tzedek Walking Tour.** Explore this artsy neighborhood featuring avant-garde design stores, boutiques and handicraft shops. Visit the Center for Israeli Innovation, which showcases Israel's achievements in agriculture, medicine, outer space, transportation and more.

**Free Time:** During leisure time, visit a nearby restaurant for lunch or browse for unique wares.

### Day 4 | Tel Aviv | Caesarea | Akko | Tiberias

**Enrichment: Contemporary Israel: The Old-New Land.** Learn about key events that have shaped modern Israel.

**Discovery: The White City.** Tel Aviv boasts the world's largest collection of Bauhaus-style buildings with over 1,500 examples located throughout the city. Drive through this "White City" and admire the marvelous architecture.

**Discovery: Mediterranean Coast.** In Caesarea, an archeological park first settled in the fourth century B.C., witness Herod's grand Roman theater and the notable hippodrome, once home to gladiator games and chariot racing. Gaze at Herod's spectacular aqueduct and view the Crusader Wall and fortifications. Then delve into the area's history at a multimedia presentation.

Dig into a lunch of typical Israeli cuisine. During your time in Israel, you may eat fresh pita with tasty hummus; *shwarma*, a grilled lamb often served with bread; or *knafeh*, a shredded pastry with cheese and sweet syrup.

**Discovery: Ancient Akko.** Encounter the well-preserved, walled city of historic Akko. This old Arab locale near the Mediterranean Sea was a bustling port city for over 4,000 years. Today, the city's picturesque waterfront has magnificent

stone buildings, beautiful archways, and a maze of alleyways, churches and green-roofed mosques. Note the thick fortifications, imposing towers and splendid 18th-century ramparts of the Old City.

In Tiberias, check in to the U Boutique Kinneret Hotel by the Sea of Galilee.

#### Day 5 | Tabgha | Capernaum | Golan

##### **Discovery: Upper Galilee and Capernaum.**

Embark on a scenic cruise on the Sea of Galilee (weather permitting), and visit Tabgha, a fishing village on the northwest shore. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes, believed by many to be the site of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. In Capernaum, visit an ancient synagogue with Jewish motifs and see the House of Peter, a home where Jesus is believed to have lodged.

**Discovery: Golan Winery.** From Merlot to sauvignon blanc, relish local vintages during a tasting at a winery in the Golan Heights region. This area of Israel is recognized as one of the country's most favorable grape-growing regions.

#### Day 6 | Meggido | Haifa | Jerusalem

##### **Discovery: Tel Megiddo – A Focus on Archeology.**

Explore the archaeological mound of Megiddo, a fascinating UNESCO World Heritage site. These impressive ruins have more than 25 layers of settlements! See the fortified cities and walk through an underground tunnel. This Iron Age structure once supplied the city's residents with water from a nearby spring.

**AHI Connects: Meet the People.** Indulge in an authentic Druze lunch with a local family in their home. Druze cuisine is characterized by special blends of spices such as turmeric, cumin, cinnamon and paprika.

**Discovery: Mount Carmel.** Haifa is Israel's third-largest city and a high-technology industrial center. From a terrace on Mount Carmel, revel in sprawling vistas of the city beyond. The pretty Bahá'í Gardens, comprised of 19 terraces, rest on the lower slopes of Mount Carmel.

Check in to the King David Jerusalem hotel.

**Enrichment: *Is it Finally Time for a Peace Deal?*** Tonight, listen as an expert presents an assessment of Israeli-Palestinian relations during a fascinating lecture and discussion.

### **Day 7 | Jerusalem**

**Discovery: *In-depth Jerusalem.*** The ancient city of Jerusalem is the spiritual heart of three world faiths — Judaism, Islam and Christianity. Discover the many religious shrines, temples, churches and mosques housed in the Old City of Jerusalem. See Temple Mount and pause at the Western Wall. Walk along a portion of the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Enjoy panoramic views from the Mount of Olives and explore the interpretive Davidson Center.

Lunch on delectable falafels in the Arab Quarter, a neighborhood with narrow alleys and souks brimming with spices, textiles and leather goods.

**Free Time:** You may wish to continue exploring Jerusalem's many wonders and inspiring sites.

### **🌍AHI Connects: *Shabbat Dinner.***

Experience an authentic Shabbat dinner with a welcoming, local family. Learn about key concepts of this weekly observance and share *challah*, a delicious bread made with eggs.

### **Day 8 | Masada | Ein Bokek | Jerusalem**

**Discovery: *Judean Desert Drama and a Sea of Salt.*** Spend a poignant morning at the site of Masada, an isolated flattop rock overlooking the Dead Sea. Then descend 1,378 feet below sea level to Ein Bokek on the shoreline of the Dead Sea, the deepest hypersaline lake in the world.

Surrounded by a barren expanse of painted mountainous desert, the Dead Sea is fed by the River Jordan, which flows from the Sea of Galilee. Relax on the beach or enjoy a swim. Savor lunch with a view near the Dead Sea.

## Day 9 | Jerusalem

### Discovery: A Poignant Monument.

Yad Vashem is Israel's memorial and place of commemoration for the millions who perished

in the Holocaust. Carved out of the hillside, the sprawling complex has 10 exhibition halls, each dedicated to a different chapter of the Holocaust. Tour the exhibition halls and galleries, and see the Hall of Names, a memorial to the lives taken during the Holocaust.

**Enrichment: A Survivor Speaks.** Join a question-and-answer session with a Yad Vashem guide and hear a personal account of his or her experiences during World War II.

**Free Time:** Craft your own itinerary at Machane Yehuda, a bustling local market. Shop at open-air stalls, sample local specialties or browse for colorful clothing and spices.

Gather this evening for a Farewell Dinner with your fellow travelers and share your favorite experiences from your time in Israel.




