Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Santiago, Chile.

Day 2 | Santiago, Chile

Upon arrival, transfer To to the Hotel Cumbres Lastarria. Welcome to Santiago's cultural center! This inviting, artsy section of the city is anchored by famed institutions such as the Museum of Fine Arts overlooking leafy Parque Forestal and the GAM, a performing arts center named for Chile's Nobel laureate poet Gabriela Mistral. Join your Travel Director this afternoon for a short walk that will familiarize you with the area around your hotel.

Enrichment: Chilean History. Dive into the timeline of the country's development, from its indigenous groups and the conquest by Spain to the struggle for freedom and the modern era.

Meet and socialize with your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner this evening.

Day 3 | Santiago

Discovery: Santiago. Explore this stimulating city noted for its eye-catching blend of colonial and modern architecture. At the Museo de la Memoria y los Derechos Humanos, grasp the

human cost of the nation's turbulent past through poignant exhibits that chronicle the human rights violations of Chile's military dictatorship from 1973–1990. Afterward, on a scenic tour, admire the presidential seat, the neoclassical Palacio de la Moneda. Pass by the palm-lined Plaza de Armas, a central hub since 1541. Linger for awhile in hip Bellavista, buzzing with cafés, art galleries and restaurants. Pablo Neruda, the celebrated Nobel laureate poet, once resided in this bohemian *barrio*, or neighborhood.

Discovery: *Tastes of Santiago.* Sample enticing Chilean cooking and learn about local customs on a visit to the lively Mercado Central.

Free Time: Explore more this afternoon.

Enrichment: *Contemporary Chile.* Examine the economic and political issues that dominate national conversation.

Day 4 | Puerto Montt | Puerto Varas

After breakfast, depart for Santiago's airport and fly to Puerto Montt. Transfer to Puerto Varas and check in to the Enjoy Puerto Varas Hotel overlooking the shores of Lake Llanquihue in southern Chile's enchanting Lake District.

** Active Travel for Cultural Explorers

This **active program** is designed for people who are in good health and can comfortably participate in a demanding daily schedule of physical activities. The itinerary may feature full days of ongoing activities. Depending on the excursion, more leisurely alternatives may be available.

Excursions on this program require:

- ▶ walking distances of up to 3-5 miles
- walking on cobblestones, unpaved paths and/or uneven surfaces
- ▶ getting on/off motor coaches and boats

Day 5 | Chiloé Island

Discovery: Chiloé Island. Ferry across the Chacao Channel to this picturesque island on the archipelago of Chiloé that boasts lush countryside and sweeping coastlines. Stop in Chacao to stroll through its town square and see its local church. In Ancud, visit the Museo de Las Iglesias de Chiloé to learn how the island's unique wooden churches, built by Spanish Jesuit missionaries in the 17th century, were constructed with native materials. Next, observe Humboldt and Magellanic penguins and other wildlife from a boat that takes you close to their natural habitats. It's one of the few places in the world where you can witness both species of penguins nesting side-by-side.

Day 6 | Puerto Varas

AHI Connects: Chilean Ranch Visit.

Meet huasos, the country's cowboys, who will demonstrate the horsemanship required in rodeo, the national sport. Feast on tasty local dishes fresh from the grill at an asado, a Chilean barbecue, then celebrate with folk music and a spirited cueca, the national dance.

Free Time: The rest of your day is at leisure. Appreciate your stunning surroundings on a leisurely walk along the lakeshore in Puerto Varas, and check out the town's charming, distinctive architecture, influenced by 19th-century settlers from Germany and Austria.

Enrichment: The History of the Patagonia.

Trace the intriguing history of this immense, wild region in the southernmost part of South America, which is shared by Chile and Argentina.

Day 7 | Puerto Montt | Punta Arenas | Puerto Natales

After breakfast, depart for Puerto Montt's airport and fly to Punta Arenas.

Discovery: *Punta Arenas.* Take a panoramic tour of this historic port city set on the Strait of Magellan between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. Before the Panama Canal opened in 1914, it prospered as a coal refueling station for steamships and as the center of the Chilean wool industry. See the highlights, including mansions built by wool barons in its heyday, and enjoy lunch on your own afterward.

Rejoin the group and continue to Puerto Natales. Check in to the Hotel Costaustralis.

Day 8 | Puerto Natales

Discovery: Balmaceda and Serrano Glaciers. Take in vistas of emerald hillsides.

rugged mountains and tall waterfalls as you cruise on the Ultima Esperanza Fjord to view the impressive hanging glacier, Balmaceda. Then, on an invigorating walk, follow your guide into the unspoiled beauty of Bernardo O'Higgins National Park to see the spiky Serrano glacier nestled above a peaceful lake where tiny icebergs float. Chat about what you've seen over a hearty lunch at a nearby Patagonian ranch, and then cruise back to Puerto Natales.

Day 9 | Torres del Paine National Park

Discovery: Torres del Paine National Park.

Spectacular, wild scenery awaits you on a scenic drive in this acclaimed national park, a UNESCO

Torres del Paine National Park

This sublimely beautiful National Park stretches across 935 square miles in Chile's southern tip. Founded in 1959, its astonishing landscape encompasses turquoise lakes, glaciers, rolling valleys, snowcapped summits and sculptural icebergs. Its crowning jewels are the Cuernos del Paine (pronounced *pine-ay*) mountains and the craggy trio of steel-gray granite peaks, the Torres del Paine, or Towers of Paine, that jut up into the clouds. An abundance of wildlife adds to the park's allure. Approximately 25 species of mammals live within the park, including the tawny guanaco, a close relative of the llama; gray and red foxes; the endangered Patagonian huemul deer; and the puma, the largest and most elusive. Andean condors swirl in the skies above, and flightless, ostrich-like birds called Lesser Rheas sprint across the grasslands propelled by their large wings.

Biosphere Reserve. Gaze in wonder at mirrorlike, aquamarine lakes, rivers of ice, golden fields and the dramatic silhouette of the snow-covered Cuernos del Paine, or Horns of Paine, mountain range. At the Salto Grande waterfall, hear the thunderous crash as water cascades from Lake Nordenskjöld into Lake Pehoé. From this vantage point, soak up the magnificent landscape at different angles. Along the way, enter a huge cave where the prehistoric remains of a Milodon, a giant ground sloth, were discovered in 1895.

Day 10 | Punta Arenas | Santiago

After breakfast, depart for the airport in Punta Arenas. Fly to Santiago and check in to the Hotel Cumbres Lastarria.

Tonight, gather with your fellow travelers at a restaurant in the area for a Farewell Dinner in honor of your memorable Chilean adventure!

Day 11 | Santiago

Free Time: Create your own agenda in the city, or join today's Elective Activity.

Elective | Viña del Mar and Valparaíso.

Travel to pretty Viña del Mar, a favorite vacation getaway of Chileans, known for its wide beaches and manicured gardens. Then, relish the quirky charms of oceanside Valparaíso, a UNESCO World Heritage site, founded in the 16th century. See the historic Victoria and Sotomayor squares



and delight in its *cerros*, or hills, packed with a jumble of colorful houses, snaking pathways, quaint funiculars and vivid, bold street art. Ride up Cerro Bellavista with free time for lunch and exploring.

Transfer 3 to the airport for your international flight 4 home. Depending upon flight schedules, some travelers may arrive home today.

Day 12 | In Transit

Arrive home in your gateway city.
