Robert Buswell, Department of Asian Languages & Cultures, holds the Irving and Jean Stone Endowed Chair in Humanities at UCLA, where he is also Distinguished Professor of Buddhist Studies. He is a specialist in the meditative traditions of Buddhism. Buswell was ordained as a Buddhist monk in Thailand and lived as a monk in Asia for seven years. He has published extensively on Buddhism, including a recounting of his five years as a Zen

monk in Korea. His most recent book, *Numinous Awareness is Never Dark*, explores whether enlightenment is a product of a gradual process of meditative development or a sudden burst of insight. (Spoiler alert: it's both.)
