

Paducah today is driven largely by the arts community—murals adorn a massive downtown floodwall and the refurbished Hotel Metropolitan salutes legends who played here like Ellington, Armstrong, and Calloway.

Nov 4: Savannah, Tennessee

Savannah invites visitors to explore its well-preserved heritage and collection of historic homes and mansions, including the Cherry Mansion, which was commandeered by General Ulysses S. Grant during the Civil War. Outside of town is the unforgettable Shiloh National Military Park, the site of the Civil War's largest engagement in the Mississippi River Valley.

Included Excursions: Shiloh National Military Park

Dr. Curt Fields, Jr.

E. C. (Curt) Fields, Jr., PhD., has been an avid and lifelong student of the American Civil War. He is the same height and body style as General Grant and, therefore, presents a convincing, true-to-life image of the general as he really looked. His presentations are in first person and quote from General Grant's memoirs, articles, letters and statements he made in interviews. Dr. Fields is a career educator, has served as a Memphis city police officer, and has appeared in numerous Civil War-related events, historical productions, and a Discovery Channel documentary.



Nov 5: Decatur, Alabama

Nestled in the Tennessee River Valley and nicknamed “The River City,” Decatur boasts a rich and colorful history. Originally a river crossing for settlers west of the Appalachian Mountains, the town became known as Decatur in 1820. Because of its strategic point on the Tennessee River, Decatur was the site of many skirmishes during the Civil War.

Included Excursions: Old State Bank Building, Historic Railroad Depot, Morgan County Archives, Princess Theater, Carnegie Visual Arts Center, a walking tour of Historic Decatur

Nov 6: River Cruising

Enjoy a literary classic while lounging in a plush chair in the Grand Lobby or Library and relish in the moment of tranquility.

Nov 7: Chattanooga, Tennessee
