DEAR UCLA ALUMNI AND FRIENDS,

Join UCLA Alumni Travel to view a total solar eclipse in 2024 at one of the premier viewing locations in the country, the Hill Country of central Texas. On April 8, 2024, the path of totality will cut through the United States from Texas to Maine plunging a 124-mile-wide swath of land into night-like darkness. The sight of the sun's ethereal corona, the 360-degree sunset, approximate four minutes of totality, and the collective awe expected across our continent are just a few of the reasons astronomers and eclipse chasers are looking forward with great anticipation to the 2024 North American total solar eclipse.

The weather prospects are excellent in the Texas Hill Country and UCLA Alumni Travel has found an exclusive viewing site that will maximize your enjoyment of this eclipse and your comfort and convenience. Accompanying us will be Professor Jean-Luc Margot, a planetary astronomer who teaches at the Department of Earth, Planetary, and Space Sciences at UCLA. Professor Margot has served as the faculty host on one previous UCLA total eclipse tour and will be providing lectures and discussions during our tour on solar eclipses and astronomy.

Gather in Austin, Texas overlooking Lady Bird Lake for a welcome dinner and orientation. The next morning head out to the Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center at the University of Texas at Austin, home to more than 900 species of native plants in both garden and natural settings. Enjoy a docent-led tour of the center and lecture on the architecture of the wildflower center and Lady Bird Johnson's environmental legacy. Journey on the scenic Hill Country when bluebonnets will be in full bloom. Arrive in time for cocktails and a dinner reception at Tapatio Springs located on 220 acres in the Hill Country. The next morning after a lecture we'll head out to an authentic Texas Ranch, tucked away in the corner of Bulverde, Texas for a true taste of Texas and its Western Heritage. Experience a private rodeo that includes a Texas longhorn cattle entrance, an awardwinning drill team, and barrel racing. Enjoy a catered Texas barbecue lunch. Afterward, tour the highlights of San Antonio including a VIP tour of the Alamo, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and a chartered cruise on a river barge. The next day after a morning lecture, prepare for the total solar eclipse at our private viewing site located in the path of the totality for optimal viewing conditions for this rare and exciting astronomical event.

The next total solar eclipse will not cross the United States until 2044, so make the most of your time in totality by securing your space on this unique tour to witness a spectacular total solar eclipse in the scenic Texas Hill Country with fellow UCLA alumni and friends.

UCLA STUDY LEADER

DR. JEAN-LUC MARGOT is a planetary astronomer and UCLA professor who conducts research on the properties of planetary bodies with a variety of spacecraft and telescopes. He has discovered binary asteroids, revealed that Mercury has a liquid core, and demonstrated that Venus experiences measurable changes in its length of day. He leads the UCLA SETI Group and has collaborated with more than 100 UCLA students, alumni, and friends in the search for life in the universe. Margot was the faculty host for UCLA Alumni Association's previous solar eclipse trip to Chile in 2019, and he observed an annular solar eclipse in Japan in 2012 and the Venus transits in 2004 and 2008.

AUSTIN, TEXAS

Fly to Austin, Texas, and transfer to our hotel overlooking Lady Bird Lake with close access to downtown Austin. Gather this evening for an orientation and welcome dinner.

SATURDAY, APRIL 6, 2024

AUSTIN / BOERNE

This morning immerse yourself in the spectacular beauty and elegance of the University of Texas at Austin Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center, the official botanic garden and arboretum of Texas. The center, founded in 1982 with the assistance of Texas' beloved former first lady and actress Helen Hayes, is located on 248 acres and has an impressive display of over 900 species of wildflowers, plants, and trees that grow in Texas, with an emphasis on Hill Country flora. The mission of the Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center is "to increase the sustainable use and conservation of native wildflowers, plants, and landscapes." We will have a lecture from Dr. Jean Luc-Margot concerning the total solar eclipse followed by a briefing on the Wildflower Center's and Lady Bird Johnson's role in conserving Texas wildflowers. After touring the Wildflower Center we'll enjoy a private catered lunch in the Center's Great Hall overlooking flowering meadows. We'll continue our journey to the Texas Hill Country along highways lined with stunning springtime bluebonnets and other wildflowers that stretch for miles. Gather for welcome cocktails and dinner at our Hill Country accommodations and eclipse site. TAPATIO SPRINGS HILL COUNTRY RESORT B, L, D

SUNDAY, APRIL 7, 2024

BOERNE / SAN ANTONIO

Depart for an authentic Texas Ranch tucked away in the corner of Bulverde, Texas to provide a true taste of Texas and its Western heritage. Attend a private rodeo demonstration with the grand entry of Texas Longhorns as well as barrel racing and an awardwinning Texas Drill team performing on horses. Enjoy a catered Texas barbecue lunch with a full bar. After lunch head to San Antonio for a city tour of its landmarks and cultural hotspots. Take a VIP tour of the Alamo to see the UNESCO World Heritage Site and learn of the heroic battle of 1836 for Texas' independence from Mexico. After touring the Alamo, embark on a privately chartered river barge along San Antonio's famous riverwalk. Finally, experience firsthand some of San Antonio's Hispanic heritage and the flavors of old Mexico at El Mercado. After exploring Mexican artifacts, jewelry, and other crafts, gather for dinner at a local restaurant before we head back to Boerne to prepare for the eclipse. 
PRE-TRIP EXTENSION

APRIL 4-5, 2024

AUSTIN, TEXAS TOUR

Arrive a day early and discover Austin on a city tour that will give you a snapshot of Austin from its Capitol dome, the UT campus and downtown to its funky neighborhoods only a local would know about. This tour is jam-packed with history and information on the people, music, culture, and food of Austin. Lunch will be at one of Austin's iconic eateries. After lunch we'll head out to a local brewery for a tasting of some of Austin artisan beers. Includes lunch, transportation, tour guide, and one extra night at the Austin Hyatt Regency. Minimum of 10 passengers.





ACCOMMODATIONS

HYATT REGENCY AUSTIN

Located in downtown Austin on the shores of Lady Bird Lake, the Hyatt Regency Austin is a full-service hotel that offers cool, contemporary new guest rooms. Situated along the Hike & Bike trail, this luxury hotel is within walking distance to all of downtown Austin's major entertainment districts, and 7 miles from Austin Bergstrom International Airport. Take a five-minute walk to Congress Ave Bridge near sunset in the summer to catch Austin's famous bat show, featuring more than 1.5 million Mexican free-tailed bats. Austin Hyatt Regency has a seasonal outdoor swimming pool with a sundeck overlooking the lake. Free WiFi is available throughout the property.

TAPATIO SPRINGS RESORT

BOERNE, TEXAS

The Resort is nestled in the heart of the Hill Country on 220 acres among rolling hills, wildflowers, and limestone cliffs and features an 18-hole championship golf course, a driving range, a putting green, and a pro shop. A private balcony or patio with a view is featured in each guest room. Rooms feature complimentary bottled water and coffee/tea makers. A seating area, LED TV, refrigerator, coffee maker, and work desk are also provided. Guests can enjoy many recreational activities on the grounds, including golf, frisbee golf, golf lessons, hiking trails, two outdoor pools, fire pits, and a full-service spa. Other amenities include restaurants, a fitness center, and a bar/lounge. Free wi-fi in all the rooms.





WHAT TO EXPECT

This expedition is designed for UCLA alumni and friends who are interested in learning and experiencing a total solar eclipse as well as the flora and fauna of the Texas Hill Country and the history and culture of San Antonio, Texas. The pace of walks will be leisurely. Average temperatures in Austin and the Texas Hill Country will be approximately between 80° and 59° F. The accommodations and some excursions in this departure will be shared with the Harvard Alumni Association. UCLA Alumni Association will have its own tour director, buses, lecture space, and eclipse viewing site. Since some travel will be in remote areas, everyone must be flexible concerning time schedules, weather, and dust. To enjoy this trip, a spirit of adventure and anticipation and the desire to explore spectacular natural areas as well as urban areas are a must. There are a couple of relatively long drives in the Texas Hill Country (approximately 2 and a half hours), which are necessary for the chance to explore the superb wildflowers of Texas and for a visit to a Texas Ranch. Travel is by regularly scheduled jet aircraft, boat (for some optional day excursions), and motorcoach. Travel is by boat (on the San Antonio river cruise) and by motorcoach.

PROGRAM NOTE:

The Texas Hill Country will be a prime location to experience the Great American Total Solar Eclipse on April 8, 2024. We will provide an optimal viewing location to experience this phenomenon. Please keep in mind that because viewing the total solar eclipse will be weather dependent, there is always a chance that passengers will not be able to view it or view it only for a short period of time. Neither Royal Adventures nor the UCLA Alumni Association makes any guarantees as to the viewing of the total solar eclipse.
