Growing up in Croatia under a communist regime and coming of age amidst the break-up of former Yugoslavia, Zrinka Stahuljak was drawn to the study of the Middle Ages, a formative period for European early modern and modern identities and nations. She is the author of 7 books and numerous articles on topics ranging from the 11th to the 16th century. Her latest book "Fixers" (2024) expands the analysis of translators and interpreters beyond the purely linguistic function to show that bilingual communication is a history of multi-functional agents who act as local informants, guides, brokers, personal assistants, enablers, facilitators and more. She has been engaged in public humanities, such as the collaborations with the J. Paul Getty Museum and a TV show on the Holy Grail that aired on the French-German channel ARTE.

Day 2 | Zagreb, Croatia

Tour the cemetery, then return to Zagreb's beautifully preserved upper town, home to more treasures by Bollé, including the fantastic St. Mark's Church.

Day 4 | Zagreb

Free Time: Make your own discoveries in Zagreb today or join our elective excursion.

🌐 **Elective | Ljubljana, Slovenia.** Cross into Slovenia to discover colorful Ljubljana. Stroll along the Ljubljanica River, passing iconic bridges, shop like a local at the Central Market and browse Prešeren Square, home to the Franciscan Church of the Annunciation. Then, enjoy a cruise along the Ljubljanica River.

Day 5 | Zagreb | Plitvice Lakes National Park | Zadar

After breakfast, depart Zagreb for Zadar. En route, visit Plitvice Lakes National Park.

Plitvice Lakes National Park. This park features 16 crystal-clear terraced lakes linked by a series of waterfalls. Wander along planked

walkways and trails amid a fragrant forest.

The area is also home to nearly 160 species of birds and numerous plant species.

Continue to Zadar and board your ship.

Later, enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

If you wish, walk along the promenade to see modern attractions, including the Monument to the Sun, which celebrates Zadar's incredible and vibrant sunsets.

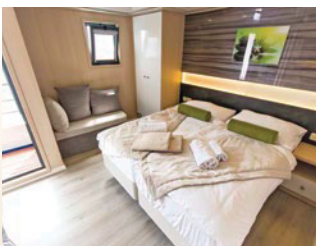

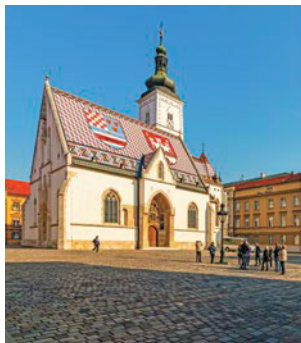
