

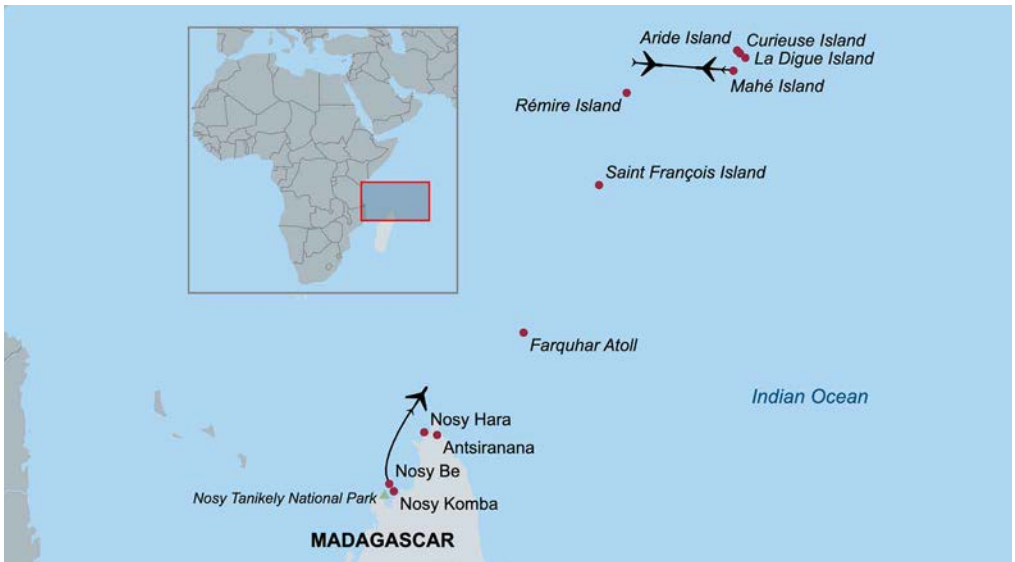

Day 1 | February 24

Depart your home city for Victoria, Mahé Island, Seychelles.

Day 2 | February 25

Victoria, Mahé Island, The Seychelles | Embark
Arrive at Seychelles International Airport and transfer to embark *Ponant Le Bougainville*. This evening, attend a welcome briefing and safety drill, followed by dinner on board.

Day 4 | February 27

B-L-R-D

La Digue Island

La Digue Island crystallizes all the beauty of the Seychelles, with inviting turquoise waters, lush vegetation sheltering giant tortoises, palm-fringed beaches and iconic granite boulders. Visit the picture-perfect Anse Source d'Argent beach. This evening,

join your fellow travelers for a Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 5 | February 28

B-L-D

Aride Island | Curieuse Island
Protected from human impact and often called a "seabird citadel," Aride is home to some 112 species of birds, including 30 species of rare birds. Take a guided walk through this pristine nature reserve. Then visit Curieuse, one of the few places where giant

Aldabra tortoises roam in the wild. Look for them — and discover lush mangrove forests, distinctive red soil and soft-sand beaches — on a guided walk.

Day 6 | March 1

B-L-D

Remire Island

Remire Island boasts unique biodiversity. On a guided walk through the island's lush vegetation, observe diverse wildlife, including endemic birds and reptiles.

Day 7 | March 2 **B-L-D**

St. François Island

Rarely visited, St. François Atoll provides a fascinating glimpse into diverse marine life without the intervention of humans. On a guided walk, spy migrating seabirds and reptiles, and interesting trees.

Day 8 | March 3 **B-L-D**

Farquhar Atoll

The extensive salt flats and shallow waters around Farquhar make it a haven for many exotic species, including the bumphead parrotfish, which thrive here. Explore the pristine beaches, mangrove forests and coastal dunes.

Marvel at the variety of seabirds, including black-naped terns, a species that lives exclusively on coral islands. Watch for distinctive frigatebirds, masked and red-footed boobies.

Day 9 | March 4 **B-L-D**

Antsiranana, Madagascar

Take an off-roading island tour in a four-wheel-drive vehicle. Head uphill to Montagne d'Ambre National Park for a hike through lush landscapes to a waterfall. You may spot lemurs, chameleons and a variety of birds. Return to port and enjoy panoramic vistas of Diego Suarez Bay and Sugar Loaf Island as you descend.

Day 10 | March 5 **B-L-D**

Antsiranana

Enjoy a taste of paradise this morning on the beautiful white sand beach along the Emerald Sea. Swim and snorkel in the clear waters, looking for bountiful marine life (including possible dolphin and whale sightings off shore!) Savor a delicious seafood lunch.

Day 11 | March 6 **B-L-D**

Nosy Hara

The unspoiled beauty of this Marine National Park is breathtaking. This veritable open-air aquarium is inhabited by: whales and dolphins, hundreds of species

of coral fish and corals, five species of sea turtles, 31 species of birds and 18 species of reptiles. Look for diverse wildlife, including Brookesia Micra, the smallest chameleon in the world. Afterward, relax on the beach, taking in the incredible vistas.

Day 12 | March 7 B-L-R-D

Nosy Komba | Nosy Tanikely | Nosy Be

On Nosy Komba, stroll through a village, and meet local people. Learn about plants cultivated on Madagascar — vanilla, ylang ylang and coffee.

Take a guided hike through the dense rainforest to encounter playful black lemurs in their natural habitat.

Lemurs are accustomed to humans and may get up-close and personal! Look out for chameleons, tortoises and birds too. This afternoon, explore Nosy Tanikely’s unique ecosystem, including its diverse birdlife and endemic plant species. While snorkeling, look for reef fish, dolphins and sea turtles; underwater, you may even hear the songs of humpback whales! This evening, join your fellow travelers

for a Captain’s Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 13 | March 8 B

Nosy Be | Disembark | Mahé Island, Seychelles | Return To Home City

Following breakfast, disembark and transfer to the airport for your included flight back to Mahé Island, Seychelles. Later in the day, board your international return flight to your home city.

Day 14 | March 9

Arrive in your home city.

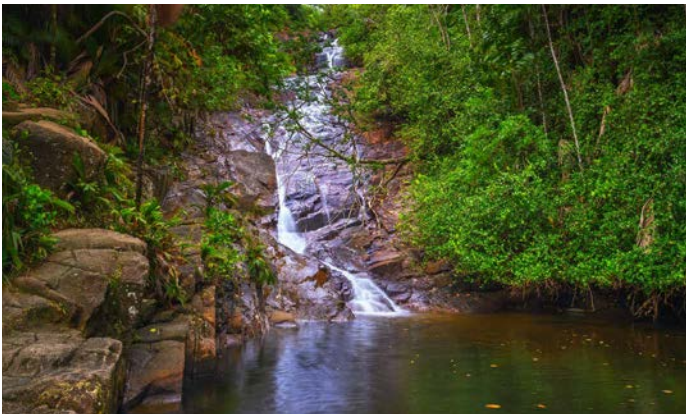
