Day 1 | In Transit

Depart for Zagreb, Croatia. 🌐

Day 2 | Zagreb, Croatia

Upon arrival, transfer 🔄 and check in to the hotel. Later tonight, gather for a convivial Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Zagreb

Enrichment: *Contemporary Croatia.*

Zagreb City Tour. Zagreb weaves European elegance with a vivacious Balkan spirit. Enjoy a panoramic tour of the modern lower town, then drive to Mirogoj Cemetery to see its tiled arcades, sculptures and green copper domes. Return to the upper town and admire its art nouveau and Austro-Hungarian architecture.

Day 4 | Zagreb

Free Time: Make your own discoveries in Zagreb today or join our elective excursion.

🌐 **Elective | Ljubljana, Slovenia.** Cross into Slovenia to discover colorful Ljubljana. Stroll along the Ljubljanica River, passing iconic bridges, shop like a local at the Central Market and browse Prešeren Square, home to the Franciscan Church of the Annunciation. Then, enjoy a cruise along the Ljubljanica River.

Day 5 | Zagreb | Plitvice Lakes National Park | Zadar

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and continue to Plitvice Lakes National Park.

Plitvice Lakes National Park. This national park boasts 16 crystal-clear terraced lakes linked by a series of waterfalls. Wander along

planked walkways and trails amid a fragrant forest. The area is also home to nearly 160 species of birds and numerous plant species.

After a lunch of regional dishes, proceed to Zadar and embark the ship. Gather for a Welcome Reception and Dinner this evening.

Free Time: Perhaps return to see the famous sea organ and light show by the promenade.

Day 6 | Zadar | Šibenik

Zadar. Get to know Zadar, a storied university town that is home to an impressive Roman Forum and the Church of St. Donatus. Learn about and sample Maraschino cherry liquor, a unique recipe first created in Zadar during the 16th century, and other locally made sweets. Set sail for Šibenik. Lunch is served on board.

Day 7 | Šibenik | Split

Cultural Šibenik. Uncover the proud city of Šibenik on a guided tour to see its winding alleys, squares and striking buildings. Visit the Cathedral of St. James, one of Europe's most

significant and monumental cathedrals.

Sail to Split. Breathe in the salty air and revel in the beauty of far-off islands on the horizon.

Split. Behold Split's many riches on a walking tour through the courtyards and chambers of Diocletian's Palace. See the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the Golden Gate and the Peristyle. Craft your own path during time at leisure.

Day 8 | Hvar

After a satisfying breakfast, cruise on to Hvar.

Hvar. Explore this sunny island and uncover a slice of paradise in the ancient port town of Stari Grad, Croatia's oldest town. Admire the churches, squares and orange-tiled rooftops clustered around the charming marina.

 **AHI Connects | Lavender Farm.** Soak up the purple beauty and delightful fragrance of lavender during a visit to a family-run lavender farm in Jesla. The blossoms are grown for medical, cosmetic, cooking and other products.

Vrboska & Winery. Learn about the local viticulture during a tour of a family winery and

enjoy a guided tasting of their legendary wines. Continue to the fishing town of Vrboska to see its fig-covered courtyards and pretty alleyways. Chat about your day during dinner at a local restaurant with a dazzling view.

Day 9 | Korčula

Settle on a sunny deck while sailing to Korčula.

Korčula. This spectacular isle, rumored to be the birthplace of Marco Polo, juts into the Pelješac Channel and brims with natural wonder. Take a guided tour of the medieval old town, filled with enduring architecture.

Day 10 | Mali Ston & Ston | Dubrovnik

Idyllic Pelješac Peninsula. Beloved for its stunning beauty, the rugged Pelješac Peninsula is abundant with fjords, quiet bays and beautiful vineyards. Today, gain insight into a centuries-old practice while visiting some of the world's oldest salt harvesting

sites. Admire the impressive 14th-century Walls of Ston, which link Ston to Mali Ston.

AHI Connects | Mali Ston Oyster Farm. Board a boat in the fishing village of Mali Ston. Ride across the bay to visit an oyster farm. Taste delicious bivalves, fresh from the sea, accompanied by sensational wine. Gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 11 | Dubrovnik

Enchanting Dubrovnik. Discover this historic city by the sea on a guided tour. Witness the Pile Gate, Europe's oldest working pharmacy and the Franciscan Monastery's cloister. View the medieval Sponza Palace and see a baroque cathedral with its collections of art and religious relics. After free time, head back to the boat and refresh over a lunch of regional cuisine.

Free Time: Opt to take a leisurely stroll along the Stradun, a wide, marble-tiled street.

Day 12 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.
