A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Paris Noir. View the enlightening 2016 documentary, "Paris Noir: African Americans in the City of Light," followed by an engaging question and answer discussion with the filmmakers.

Welcome to Paris! Familiarize yourself with the colorful neighborhood around your hotel and learn how to use the Métro subway.

Spirit of Black Paris. Venture out for an enriching overview of Black history in Paris, the city that welcomed Josephine Baker, Langston Hughes and other African American luminaries. Drive along the Champs-Élysées and stroll through the Latin Quarter, viewing favorite haunts of the expatriate community. See landmarks illustrating France's relationship with race and slavery, such as the Josephine Baker marker and Alexandre Dumas memorials.

Harlem in Paris. Explore Lower Montmartre on a guided tour to understand the influence of the Harlem Renaissance and jazz in Paris. Hear how the WWI "Harlem Hellfighters," first brought jazz to Paris, and how African American culture influenced European popular arts and culture. Pass nightclubs owned by legends Bricktop, Eugene Bullard and Josephine Baker.

Flavors of France. Delve into French gastronomy in Champ-de-Mars, at the foot of the Eiffel Tower, while tasting your way through the city's best artisan-made foods.

Musée du Quai Branly. An expert guide leads you on a tour of indigenous art and cultures of Africa, Asia, Oceania and the Americas at this premier cultural institution.

Left Bank Pioneers. African-American expatriates, along with other communities of the African diaspora, flourished on the Left Bank. Take a walking tour around the Panthéon and the Sorbonne to learn about the explosion of Black consciousness and expression through Harlem Renaissance writers, African and Caribbean intellectuals and the Négritude Movement.

Sunset Seine Cruise. Take a magical cruise through the heart of Paris when the most iconic Paris landmarks are illuminated.

An Evening of Jazz. Trace the evolution of French jazz as you stroll through the storied

Latin Quarter and Saint-Germain-des-Prés, where French jazz evolved and African American musicians played post-WWII. Learn about musical legends, followed by dinner and a concert at a local jazz club.
