### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Marseille, France. 🌐

### Day 2 | Marseille | Aix-en-Provence

Upon arrival, transfer 🚗 and check in to the hotel in Aix, your home for the week.

Enjoy a brief walking tour with your Travel Director to get acquainted with the area.

This evening, meet and mingle with your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

### Day 3 | Aix-en-Provence | Cassis

**Aix-en-Provence.** Get to know this captivating capital of Provence, your home for the week. Take a guided stroll beneath the lovely canopy of plane trees along the wide Cours Mirabeau boulevard, flanked by elegant mansions with wrought iron balconies and sculpted facades from the 17th and 18th centuries. Pass by the Cathedrale Saint-Sauveur d'Aix-en-Provence, the Place de l'Hôtel de Ville and Paul Cézanne's home. The artist was born here, returning later in life to live and establish his studio in magical Aix, where he found much inspiration.

**Cassis & its Calanques.** Take a scenic drive to Cassis, a cozy sun-drenched Provençal fishing village on the Mediterranean coast. Indulge in a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, then set out on a boat cruise through the narrow inlets of the Calanques of Marseille to marvel at the unique, dramatic limestone sea cliffs and the turquoise inlets that resemble fjords. Return to Cassis, stroll the town if time permits, and then enjoy a short train ride back to the coach.

### Day 4 | Avignon

**Palais des Papes & Avignon.** Revel in ancient history and Gothic architecture on a guided visit to the massive, medieval Pope's Palace. Tour the Old and New palaces, the papal residences for seven popes in the 14th century, when the papal court moved from Rome to Avignon. Gain insight into the palace's storied, turbulent past, and marvel at the faded, centuries-old frescoes and the Pope's Chamber, where the Pope's private apartments were located. *(Active)*

**Châteauneuf-du-Pape.** Enjoy a scenic drive to the southern Rhône valley and the famed wine-making village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Visit a winery for a tour and lunch, and savor a tasting of the classic, full-bodied Rhône wines.

**Pont Du Gard.** Visit the remarkably preserved Pont du Gard, a massive three-tiered aqueduct built by the Romans in 19 B.C. to carry water to Nîmes. Contemplate the Roman engineering and construction mastery as you walk across the awe-inspiring bridge and stroll around the scenic, natural surroundings on the Gard River.

## Day 5 | Arles | Les Baux | St. Remy

**Arles.** Set out on a walking tour of Arles' winding cobblestone streets, brimming with impressive monuments and ancient houses adorned with colorful shutters. Tour inside the colossal Roman Les Arènes amphitheatre, still used to stage bullfights. Stroll past the Romanesque Cathedral of St. Trôphime and Café Van Gogh, the inspiration for his iconic "Café Terrace at Night" and other paintings.

**Free Time:** Find a café for lunch and explore more of picturesque, medieval Arles to discover its rich artistic heritage at leisure.

**Les Baux & St. Remy.** Delight in visits to two quintessentially Provençal villages. Les Baux, perched atop towering limestone cliffs, boasts breathtaking views, a tiny medieval village and ancient fortress. In romantic St. Remy, gaze at the lush, perfumed valleys that inspired over 150 of Vincent Van Gogh's paintings during one of his most artistically fruitful periods.

Return to Aix for a festive group dinner tonight.

## Day 6 | Marseille

**Marseille.** This dazzling, vibrant port city on the Mediterranean coast was founded around 600 B.C. and is France's oldest city. Set out on a coach and walking tour to discover the tapestry of eclectic neighborhoods, diverse cultures and architectural wonders. See Palais Longchamp and drive along the harbor up to Notre-Dame de la Garde basilica to witness spectacular panoramic views. Stroll along the labyrinthine alleys and charming squares in Le Panier, Marseille's oldest district, soaking up the bohemian vibe of this multicultural hub.

**Free Time:** Find a café for lunch on your own and spend the remainder of the day exploring at leisure. Consider a visit to the Museum of Civilizations of Europe and the Mediterranean.
