ITINERARY

February 7: Sydney, Australia - Embark 1pm

Embark from Sydney, where the harbor shimmers beneath the recognizable white sails of the Sydney Opera House.

February 8: Cruising the Bass Strait

February 9: Melbourne, Australia

February 10: Cruising the Bass Strait

February 17: Wellington, New Zealand

February 18: Napier, New Zealand

Napier is defined by reinvention. Rebuilt after a 1931 earthquake, its Art Deco architecture stands as a cohesive, elegant statement. Surrounding vineyards and coastal light add warmth, making this city a study in resilience, design, and New Zealand's modern identity.

February 19: Gisborne, New Zealand 📍

Gisborne is among the first places in the world to see the sunrise. Known for its Maori heritage and fertile land, this region tells deeper stories of settlement and cultural continuity, where traditions remain strong, and the landscape is shaped by the sea.

February 20: Rotorua (Tauranga), New Zealand

Rotorua is New Zealand's geothermal and cultural heart, where steam vents and mineral-rich earth reveal powerful volcanic forces beneath the surface. Maori traditions reflect generations of knowledge tied to the land, offering insight into how the environment and culture remain closely connected.

February 21: Auckland, New Zealand - Disembark 8am 📍

Disembark in Auckland, a city spanning two harbors and volcanic hills. Polynesian heritage, sailing culture, and vibrant neighborhoods create a striking blend of natural beauty and modern life on the edge of the Pacific.
