### **March 31: Tokyo, Japan - Embark 1pm** 📺

Embark in Tokyo, where centuries-old temples and modern high-rises exist side by side.

### **April 1: Nagoya, Japan**

Nagoya sits at the center of Japan's manufacturing heartland, long associated with samurai clans and the rise of the automotive industry. Castles, museums, and regional food traditions show how craftsmanship has shaped modern Japanese society.

### **April 2: Kyoto (Kobe), Japan**

Kobe grew as one of Japan's first open ports to foreign trade. Framed by mountains and water, the city is known for its livability, access to nature, and a slower, more relaxed pace than many of Japan's larger cities

### **April 3: Kochi, Japan**

Sun-lit and Pacific-facing, Kochi boasts open skies and a relaxed coastal atmosphere. Mountains rise close to the coast, and clear rivers cut through the town, where Kochi Castle still stands at the city's center.

### **April 4: Kagoshima, Japan**

Kagoshima stretches along a broad bay beneath an active volcano, visible from nearly everywhere in the city. Ferries cross the water throughout the day, while historic gardens and hot springs reflect long-standing regional traditions.

### **April 5: Nagasaki, Japan**

From the harbor, compact Nagasaki rises uphill. European-built churches and former trading districts reflect centuries of foreign presence. At the same time, atomic bomb memorials and preserved ruins appear alongside homes and schools, tying World War II history directly to this modern city.

### **April 6: Busan, South Korea**

In Busan, fishing boats fill the harbor, seafood markets open early, and temples overlook the water, where fresh-caught fish, steaming broths, and market cooking shape everyday eating habits within a city built closely around its working shoreline.

### **April 7: Fukuoka (Hakata), Japan**

Facing the Korea Strait, Fukuoka is one of Japan's fastest-growing cities, with a strong startup culture and a skyline marked by Fukuoka Tower, the country's tallest seaside tower overlooking Hakata Bay.

### April 8: Hiroshima, Japan

Rivers divide Hiroshima into low, flat islands connected by bridges and trams. The Atomic Bomb Dome and nearby memorial grounds sit within walking distance of local life. In spring, cherry trees line the riverbanks, creating the perfect setting for an evening walk.

### April 9: Cruising the Pacific Ocean

A day at sea offers a relaxing change of pace. Attend an expert talk that deepens cultural context, read on deck while watching the horizon shift, or settle in for an exquisite dining experience, inspired by the regions along the route.

### April 10: Shimizu, Japan

Shimizu is considered one of Japan's most beautiful and iconic landscapes. On clear mornings, Mount Fuji is visible beyond the bay. Fishing boats and waterfront streets define local life and reflect a long maritime economy.

### April 11: Tokyo, Japan - Disembark 8am

Returning to Tokyo brings the journey full circle, with the city's vibrant streets, rivers, and layered skyline offering a final backdrop for reflection.
